### Reduce

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## Reuse is Real Use

### Benefits of Reuse

- Reduce items going to landfill, emitting greenhouse gases
- Avoid unnecessary consumption of energy and materials to produce new items
- Provide good quality reused items to people who need them.

### How to reuse – unwanted items that are still in good condition can be:

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## Reuse Scheme

- Clothes and shoes (pairs tied up)
- DVDs and CDs
- Books and stationery
- Cosmetics and household items

- Electrical items, mobile phones and desk lamps
- Non-perishable sealed or canned food
