

## Collated Suggestions for events during Fairtrade Fortnight

- Fairtrade fashion show
- FT unfair football match (staff v students)
- Raffles and quizzes with donated prizes from local FT shops, and suppliers (Co-op etc)
- FT wine-tasting eve.
- Films
  - One tip about film viewings - try and find out if any FT films are likely to be on tv during FT Fortnight. We arranged for the cinema to put on a screening of Black Gold last year, but it ended up being shown on tv the night before, so the turnout wasn't very good.
- Fairtrade 'banana bash' - a relay race involving large inflatable fairtrade bananas as the relay batons. Teams competed down an 'it's a knockout'-style obstacle course. Very visual. Local stockists of fairtrade goods /Fairtrade supporters were invited to form teams. It was organised by the local fairtrade forum and held in the town centre, but could perhaps be done on campus too?
- SU president dressed as a FT banana - The SU pres. gave out free fairtrade bananas at uni Fairtrade fair
- Fairtrade specials on the menu - Uni catering outlets
- Fairtrade Coffee Crawl where a group of people (about 15) visiting all of the local coffee shops to drink Fairtrade coffee where it was available and encourage cafes to stock it where it wasn't available.
- Banana trail where clues were left around a park on card shaped like a banana (Fairtrade of course) and once you had all the clues you could work out the answer. Those people who got it right won a Fairtrade prize
- Salsa evening - trial lesson, and FT food and drink
