# What is Green Impact?

Departmental accreditation scheme with awards element History:

- Founded upon Sound Impact Awards
- Piloted at the University of Bristol three years ago
- 22 Universities took part in 2009/10
- 35 Universities and colleges took part in 2010/11
- 46 participating this year



#### **National level results**

- 35 universities and colleges took part in 2010/11
- 621 teams- 35,467 staff
- 3,985 people directly involved in a Green Impact committee
- 19,620 greening actions were completed!
- 495 student and staff auditors trained




