Motivations

- 105,000 sq m (GIA) non-residential estate
- Mostly built in the 1990s and 2000s
- Relatively high energy intensity
- Goal: to improve space and energy performance by aligning occupiers' interests more closely with the University's interests

Key choices

- Goal: effective incentive
- Simple and easily understood
- Emphasis on energy performance
- Minimum bureaucracy; no "cottage industry"
- Low cost to implement and administer
- Zero-infrastructure approach


Key choices

Replaced TRAC bands





