



Le Gusta Oven & Bar (Warwick Arts Centre) Mediterranean and Middle Eastern style cuisine and stone oven baked pizzas.


Xananas (Students' Union) Full English breakfast and seasonal specials to suit a wide variety of tastes. Freshly prepared using locally sourced ingredients.




