- Finalising our response to the International Development Committee's Inquiry on UK progress on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- Finalising a report based on member responses to our Advocacy survey. This will then feed into 2019
 Advocacy plans.
- Joined the Healthy Universities network.
- Having spoken to the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, we are now looking at partnership opportunities for the Year of Green Action.
