




Better World Books is a for-profit socially minded business that collects books and sells them online, with each sale generating funds for literacy initiatives around the world.

- In partnership with EAUC, Better World Books has an excellent opportunity to collect books from across University Campuses through Book Banks.
- Better World Books provide Book Banks free of charge to the client at mutually agreed location(s).
- The client lets Better World Books know when the Book Bank needs emptied or, if a collection pattern occurs, Better World Books can arrange to collect on an agreed cycle.
- Better World Books arrange for the collection of the books at a time convenient to the client, again, free of charge. Better World Books' courier would need to gain access to the recycling centres when collecting and be able to park next to the Book Bank as the books will be manually removed from the bank.
- The books are then transported to Better World Books' warehouse.
- Each book is scanned into Better World Books' database. The system will not accept all books for sale, either because they are not in a good enough condition or because there are sufficient copies of that title. These items will either be donated or recycled. NOTHING goes to landfill.
- Better World Books sell the accepted books across multiple online marketplaces and betterworldbooks.co.uk. Any unsold books are donated to literacy initiatives, or recycled. Again, NOTHING goes to landfill.
- A percentage of net sales is allocated with any payment generated quarterly.
- Book Bank dimensions are 121x135x173cm
