





- Gold version (sign off to receive SCORM file)

Myth busting (the problem is wider than crisp packets etc)


Jargon busting (reiterating concepts and definitions that we use in our targets and strategies)

20 minutes - 3000 words



Lessons Learned

Can't cover everything – need to focus


It takes a while to get the wording right, especially when you see it in different formats

3 of us working on it – need an eye for detail

Be prepared to drop everything and focus on edits for a few hours when sign off is coming up

May need to couple this with website updates if you plan to link to guidance/policies
