NEW CATEGORIES AND INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION

2012 looks set to be another amazing year for the Green Gown Awards. Last year, we saw a record 240 entries. With the introduction of two new categories for 2012 'Best Newcomer' and 'Modernisation – Effectiveness and Efficiency in the Estate', we hope to see the number of applications surpass last year's record. There are fantastic sustainability initiatives taking place across the sector, so we are looking forward to seeing even more innovative projects and pioneering enterprises.

The ongoing popularity of the Green Gown Awards in the UK, which are administered by the EAUC and governed by a cross agency steering group, has meant they now have an international presence in the Australasian Green Gown Awards. In 2012, to further develop links between the UK and Australasian Awards, three categories will have an international element with winners from across the UK and Australasia competing for the coveted International Award category. The three international categories are: 'Continuous Improvement: Institutional Change', 'Social Responsibility' and 'Student Initiatives and Campaigns'.

The ethos of the Green Gown Awards is to ensure that the lessons learnt and the examples of good practice highlighted by entries are shared throughout the sector, and we are working hard with the Award partners to ensure this information is disseminated far and wide.
