
Subsidised by Transport Scotland, the Energy Saving Trust have some Fuel Efficient Driver (FED) training sessions on offer to help your business reduce its carbon impact, save money and improve its environmental credentials.

What happens in a training session?

The approved fuel efficient driving instructor provides the car and insurance, and comes to your workplace for a day and trains 8 individuals. Each trainee is collected and returned to your premises after their 50 minute FED session. Trainees just need to remember to bring along both parts of their drivers licence.

The sessions are enjoyable and focus specifically on putting the fuel efficient driving techniques into practice. After the session all trainees receive a certificate that states their potential yearly cost and fuel savings when they continue to drive in a fuel efficient way.

Covers a lot of excellent matters on safe driving.



How much does it cost?

Our subsidised sessions are the best possible value for money. A day of 8 sessions costs £80 plus VAT (normal price £300 plus VAT) for public sector, community organisations, and businesses with less than 30 members of staff.

Larger businesses can also benefit from a subsidised rate, at £200 plus VAT (normal price £300 plus VAT).

Low Carbon Transport Loans

Reduce your carbon impact and fuel costs. Interest free loans of £500 to £50,000 are available from the Energy Saving Trust to help organisations in Scotland.

Funded by Transport Scotland, the scheme aims to support organisations that want to reduce the carbon impact and fuel costs of their transport and travel arrangements with new, more efficient alternatives.

What measures can be installed?

Interest free loans can be used to meet installation costs of a wide range of measures including:

- Video and teleconference facilities
- Cycle facilities including bicycles
- Grey fleet management software
- Vehicle efficiency devices (which do not void the manufacturer's warranty)
- Low carbon cars and vans
- Low emission pool cars

The list of measures above are not exhaustive and other measures can be considered.

What are the benefits?

- Reduction in transport and travel costs
- Lower your organisation's carbon footprint
- Improve your green credentials
- Provide more sustainable travel options to staff.

The loan offer will be up to six years.
