SHARE RESOURCES AND ENGAGE



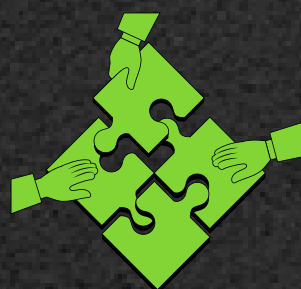
