Location of Hadlow College TN11 0AL

Main campus - near Hadlow village, 5km from Tonbridge. Good road and rail links to London and the major towns of the south-east. The nearest rail station is Tonbridge.

Rural Regeneration Centre – at College Dairy site, Blackmans Lane. See campus map.

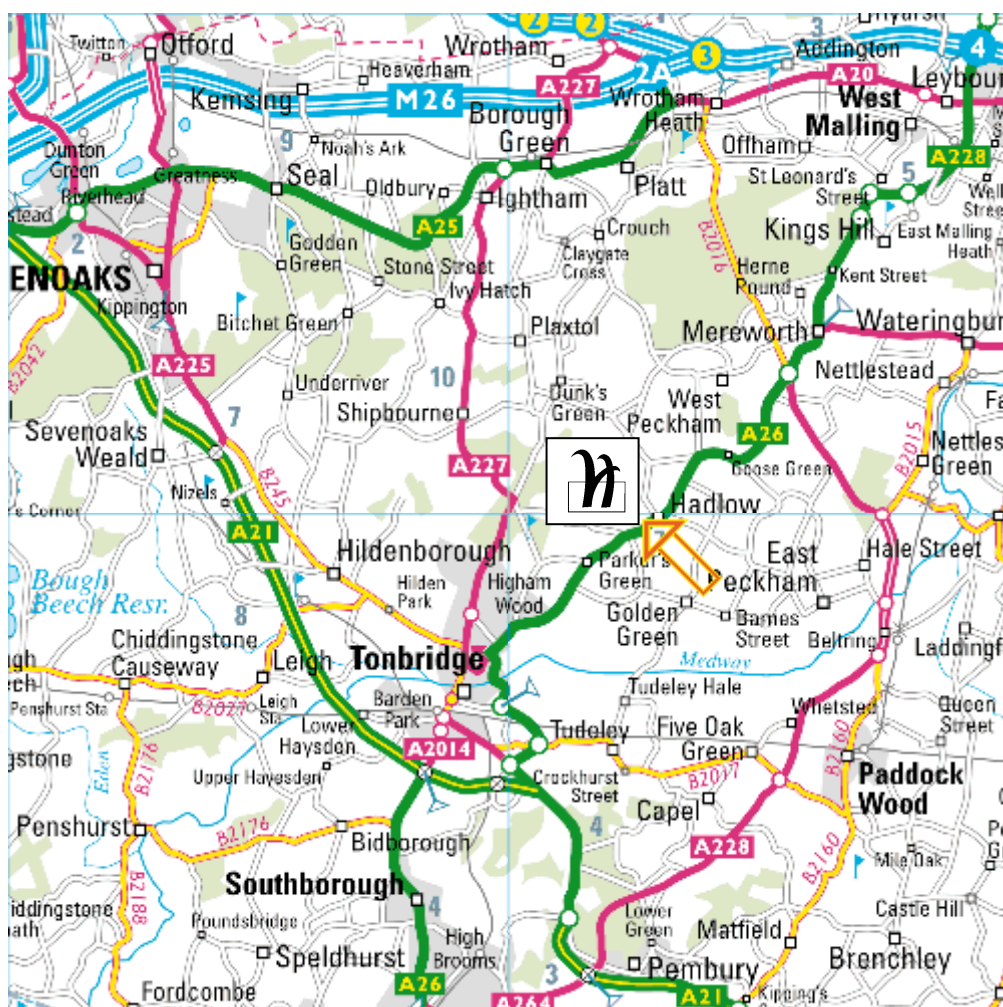
By road – from Dartford M25 direction (clockwise) – take M20 towards Dover - turn off at junction 4, follow A228 south (West Malling bypass), then A26 towards Tonbridge. The campus is located just after passing through Hadlow village on A26.

From M25 west (anticlockwise) – take M26 - turn off at junction 2A, briefly take A25/A20 for West Malling, then turn right onto B2016 (Seven Mile Lane) – at roundabout take A26 towards Tonbridge. The campus is located just after passing through Hadlow village on A26.

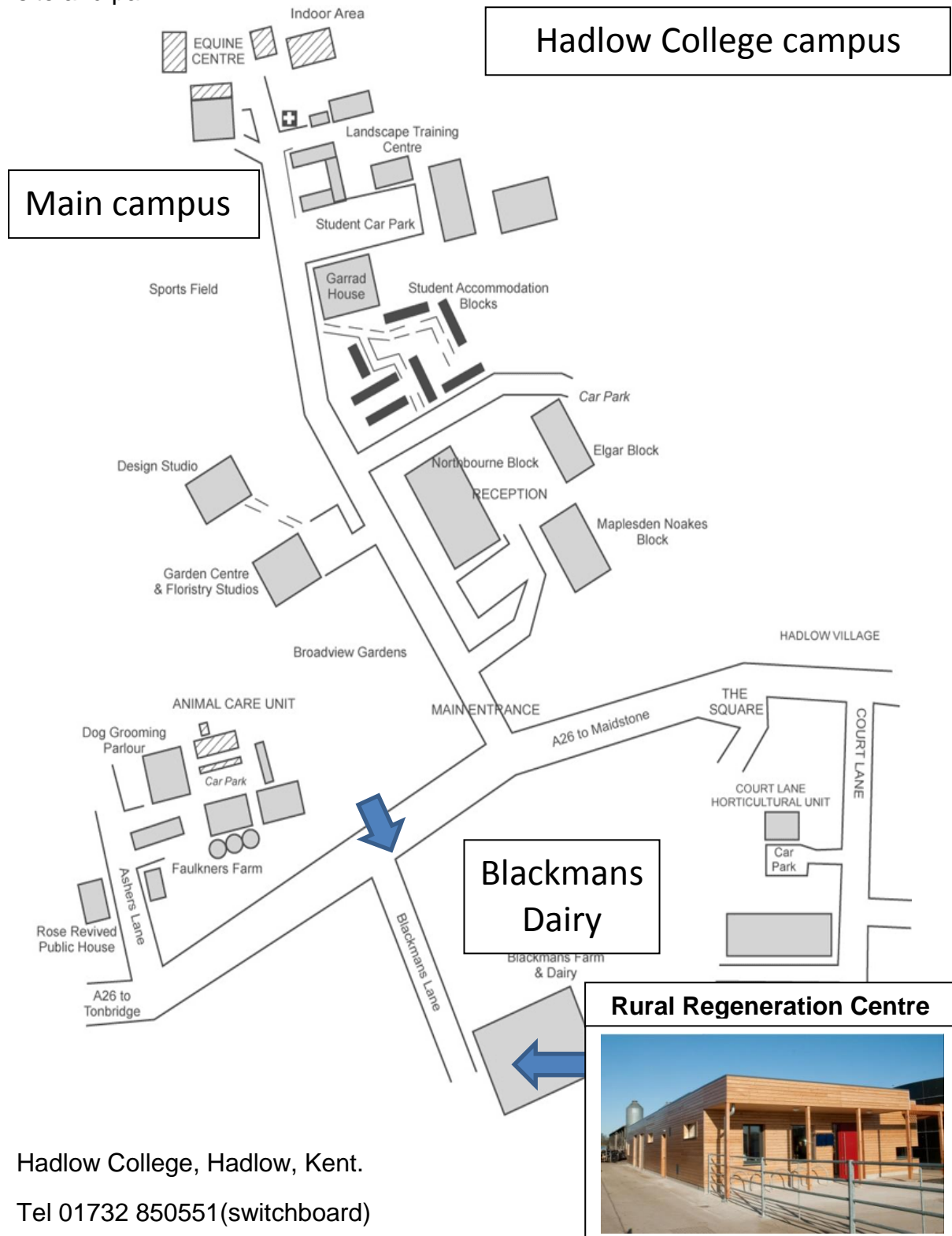
From Dover/Folkestone – join M20 until junction 4, follow A228 south (West Malling bypass), then A26 towards Tonbridge. College situated just after Hadlow village on A26. **From Ramsgate** – A259, A299, M2 west, at junction 5 go south on A249 to M20 take west towards London to junction 4 then follow A228 south (West Malling bypass), then A26 towards Tonbridge. The College is situated just after Hadlow village on the A26.
