The Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) unites all aspects of sustainable development: People, Planet, Prosperity, Peace and Partnership. To support this development, there is a need for interdisciplinary research with dual impact.

The conference “Transforming for Sustainability” strives to explore a broad range of perspectives from private and public organizations as well as academic research concerning the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Moreover, it seeks to create an inclusive community of researchers, private and public organizations from Denmark and abroad as well as promote interdisciplinary solutions to the SDGs.

The transdisciplinary themes for this year’s conference are:

During the first day of the conference, we will work on understanding some of the most urgent technological, political and behavioural challenges related to the sustainable development of cities, food and bio production, coasts and oceans. Conference participants will represent a network of experts from the private and public sector, who can engage in discussions of complex and multifaceted questions of sustainable development.
