

# Switch Off




Lights left on overnight use enough energy in a year to heat a home for almost 5 months



A typical window left open overnight in winter will waste enough energy to drive a small car over 35 miles.

If windows do not close properly, report this on the Building Maintenance System.



Leaving a PC on overnight for a year creates enough CO<sub>2</sub> to fill a double-decker bus.



A dripping tap can waste up to 10 000 litres (3000 gallons) of water a year.


That's equal to 17598 pints of beer.




A 2°C increase in room temperature creates enough CO<sub>2</sub> in a year to fill a hot air balloon.

Remember to dress for the season instead of turning the heating up.



Waiting for the tap to run cold when filling a glass with water can waste more than 10 litres a day. Why not fill a jug of water and leave it in the fridge to cool down.



If everyone boiled only the water they needed for a cup of tea, there would be enough electricity in a year to run 3/4 of the street lights in the country.
