- Tayside Recyclers (Dundee) are a non-profit making organisation and will come and collect your unwanted furniture free of charge. Contact Doug McLaren on 01382 322300.
- Edinburgh Furniture Initiative will collect furniture and white goods (they don't have to be in working order but should be repairable). Contact: Kevin O'Shaunessey on 0131 553 3444.
- To dispose of **fridges**, please contact Fife Council: 01334 412273.
- For any other bulky items, you will need to contact Fife Council for a Special Uplift: 01334 412375

Having a clear out? Remember: save money by separating out waste for recycling.

- Contact your Senior Janitor in advance of a clear out to request additional sacks for paper recycling and any confidential sacks required.
- For unwanted books try donating to Oxfam (01334 472080) or Barnados (01334 479624) or contact Jenny Evetts (x2308), Library, to discuss selling to secondhand dealers.
- For large amounts of general waste, you may need to arrange for a special uplift / skip hire from Fife Council. Contact Jim Drummond (\times 3982), Grounds, to discuss.
