2. To work together and/or share resources to help members achieve specific aims/objectives
3. To promote the principles of sustainable development to FE/HE
4. To collate and communicate views on specific issues to influence the work of EAUC and other bodies
5. To keep up to date with environmental legislation and other requirements
6. To promote the use of students to deliver environmental projects
7. To provide training opportunities
8. To investigate funding opportunities for projects
9. To encourage other FE/HE to join the group

The group is affiliated to the EAUC and so also has the following Terms of Reference and aims/objectives:

Terms of reference

1. To support the development of regional activity within the wider EAUC Membership;
2. To act as a lead point of contact for members in the Region;
3. To lead and co-ordinate regional events, where appropriate;
4. To report activities, issues and ideas to the EAUC staff and Board as appropriate; and
5. To support the wider aims and objectives of the EAUC.

Aims and objectives

1. To promote the Association at a regional level;
2. To assist the EAUC in recruiting new and retaining existing members;
3. To encourage a proactive involvement of members in the wider work of the EAUC;
4. To help seek opportunities for new funding streams at a regional level that work towards the EAUC Business Plan; and
5. Assist the staff and Board in the co-ordination of regional activity.
