
Paperless Classroom







- Trialled two modules in a paperless form to reduce resource consumption in the school of Computing, Information Technology and Engineering (CITE).
- Online student handbooks and online coursework submission.
- Approx 33,000 sheets of paper saved (from 412 students).
- Student feedback was generally positive, liked the easier submission of coursework and money savings from not printing.
- Reservations include resistance to change and fear of technology.
- Hope to expand trial to other subject areas and survey students/staff experience.
