Encouraging institutions to take a fresh look at how biodiversity fits into their environmental management agenda

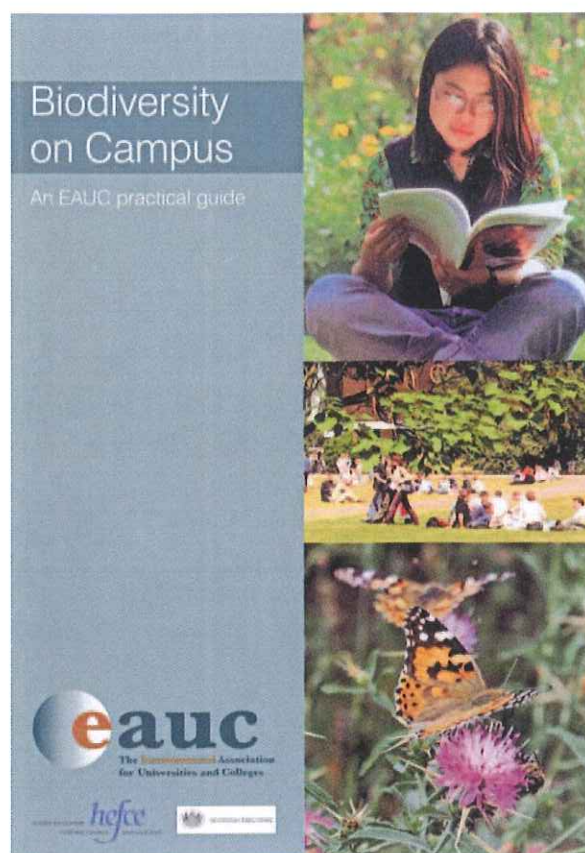
Many campuses already contain important habitats and there are always opportunities to increase biodiversity through sensitive grounds management.
